SCM Labs to Hold Open House to Announce TeamShare Partnership

DENVER – November 21, 2001 - SCM Labs, Inc., a Denver-based software configuration management (SCM) solution provider, plans an Open House to announce its partnership with TeamShare. Based in Colorado Springs, TeamShare specializes in web-architected workflow management solutions.

The event will offer product demonstrations and an informal presentation about the companies' current solutions as well as product integration plans. It will be held on December 13 between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. in SCM Labs' downtown Denver office. TeamShare and SCM Labs' current and past clients, along with others eager to

find integrated SCM solutions, are invited. Refreshments will be served.

SCM Labs will also announce its status as an authorized reseller for TeamShare's business process management and issue-tracking products.

"The Open House will celebrate and announce our partnership in a fun, relaxed atmosphere," says SCM Labs' CEO Scott Lehman. "We want our current and future customers to get to know us better, visit the office and get a feel for what the partnership and integration can mean to them in terms of comprehensive SCM solutions."

Due for availability in January 2002, the product integration will create a workflow solution that can extend from an organization's software development area, through defect and issue tracking functions, between development teams, and to customers or other users outside the development function.

Quartet is an SCM tool based on SCM Labs' proprietary methodology. It provides an end-to-end SCM solution with version control, build control, change control, and dependency control functionality. A Java-based product, Quartet can run on most any operating system. Both GUI and fully-functional command-line interfaces are included in the product.

TeamShare's tTrack is a web-architected change control tool that tracks such information as change control initiation, progress,

responsibility and status for software development and other business processes.

The seamless connection between Quartet and tTrack will give organizations the option to provide selected users outside the development group access to change requests. Authorized users can access and update change request information from their Web browser – without downloading or installing software.

“tTrack is a valuable addition to Quartet. It makes the Quartet solution truly comprehensive, and solves the problem our customers have with providing access to users outside the development group,” SCM Labs CEO Scott Lehman said.

With the Quartet and tTrack integration, both tools interface with a single data repository. The change request information is viewed and updated real-time for both types of users. There is no time delay for either user.

The interface with Quartet will allow TeamShare to offer its customers an end-to-end SCM solution. “Our customers love tTrack’s change request functionality and accessibility from the Internet,” says Dave Fuino, Director of Channel Marketing for TeamShare. “And with the Quartet integration, we can also give them a solution for the rest of their SCM needs. The interface with Quartet is just what they are looking for to complete their SCM toolset.”

Quartet’s Microsoft SCC API is an additional feature that can be used to integrate Quartet with most popular interactive development

environments (IDEs). In this scenario, developers can check files in and out, and perform other Quartet functions, directly from their development tool. Using this option in conjunction with the tTrack interface, users get a truly integrated development environment.

TeamShare and SCM Labs' partnership will also provide opportunities for each company to leverage consulting and marketing resources. SCM Labs will make its consulting staff available to TeamShare clients, and the two will co-market products, services and the Quartet/tTrack integrated solution to clients eager to find complete SCM solutions.
